IV. ATC Update/Traffic Counts

- a. Total operations were slightly down from the previous September.

a. Capital Projects Update

- Runway extension now slated to start in the spring and at the current bid costs.
- Master plan and environmental assessment for parking lot improvements now in draft form and will be brought to the Airport Board for comment.
- Hangar Development ideas are moving forward.
 - Meeting with FBO took place and they reported a need for another hangar
 1. FBO stated another larger hangar as first priority; next would be a new arrival departure building.
- PAPI Installation on Runway 5/23
 - Work is essentially completed.

- Airport share of 2007 sales tax referendum
 - Should have almost a full \$5 million minus the local share of the 13/31 extension project for future airport projects.
- b. Air Service Update
 - Allegiant load factors remain strong.
 - They'd like to go to Orlando but do not have enough airplanes and crews.
 - Sun Country charters continue to do well.
